PM.28 Licensing of Staff

Cornerstone Behavioral Healthcare (CBH) will provide the highest quality of care in accordance with established ethical and licensing guidelines*. CBH employs a multidisciplinary staff, and all staff members are expected to adhere to the ethical standards of their respective professional code of ethics.

All staff providing direct services to clients (clinicians, case managers, and peer support specialists) must hold a current and valid State of Maine professional license, registration, or certification authorizing them to provide clinical services. Proof must be submitted, displayed, and a copy must be maintained in the personnel file. Each staff member is responsible for maintaining their license, certification, or registration in good standing. Staff whose credentials expire or become invalid will not be permitted to provide services until renewed or updated. In the absence of proof of current licensing, certification, or registration, the staff member may be suspended without pay until proof is provided. Upon renewal or update, a copy must be submitted to CBH.

Non-clinical staff are expected to follow the rights of mental health and substance use disorder clients of the State of Maine.
